## The Guardian – New Europe Survey

**Fieldwork dates:** 24<sup>th</sup> February – 8<sup>th</sup> March 2011

**GB Interview Method:** Online

**Population effectively sampled:** All adults aged 18-64 years

**Sampling Method:** In the UK, a nationally representative sample was selected at random from the NewVista™ panel of 200,000 adults, with sample selected in proportion to population distribution. Panel members are recruited via ICM's telephone and face to face surveys and via online recruitment and give detailed demographic and consumption data.

In each of the other European countries, respondents were selected at random from domestic online panel suppliers using methods standard to each country.

**Sample size:** 5,023

UK = 1,001; Germany = 1,005; France, 1,004; Spain 1,003; Poland 1,010

**Data weighting:** Data were weighted to the profile of all country adults aged 18-64. Data were weighted by sex, age, social class. Targets for the weighted data were derived from national sources in each country eg. National Readership Survey in the UK.

**Questions:** The computer tables attached in PDF format show each question, in full, in the order they were put to respondents, all response codes and the weighted and un-weighted bases for all demographics and other data including but not limited that published .
