

ICM interviewed a random sample of 1,203 adults aged 18+ between 7th-9th July, 1998. Interviews were conducted across the country and the results have been weighted to the profile of all adults.

Q If there were a general election tomorrow, which party would you vote for?

Conservative	31%
Labour	47%
Lib Dem	17%
Other	4%
Lead	16%

Q1 Do you think Britain would be better off or worse off without a Royal Family?
