

MAIL ON SUNDAY MONARCHY POLL - JULY 1998

ICM Research interviewed a random sample of 651 adults aged 18+ face to face on 10-11th July 1998. Interviews were conducted across the country and the results have been weighted to the profile of all adults.

Q1. Do you feel that on balance, that it would be in the interests of Prince Charles two sons, William and Harry, for him to re-marry?	
Yes	26%
No	47%
Don't know	26%

Q2. Do you feel that on balance, that Prince Charles should now marry his long term companion Camilla Parker Bowles, end his relationship or leave things as they are?	
Marry	25%
End the relationship	15%
Leave things as they are	45%
Don't know	15%

Q3. Thinking only about the interests of Prince William and Harry, do you think Charles should end his relationship with Camilla or not?	
Yes	29%
No	57%
Don't know	14%

Q4. On balance, do you think Prince Charles was right or wrong to let his son, Prince William meet Camilla Parker Bowles recently?	
Right	66%
Wrong	21%
Don't know	13%

Q5. Do you think Prince Charles should or should not give up his right to be the next monarch in favour of his eldest son, Prince William?	
Should	41%

Should not	48%
Don't know	11%

Q6. Which of the following statements about Camilla Parker Bowles most closely matches your own views?

I like her and would accept her as future Queen	8%
I like her but do not think she should become Queen	37%
I dislike her but would accept her as a future Queen	2%
I dislike her and do not think she should become Queen	35%

Q7. If Prince Charles were to marry Camilla Parker Bowles, do you think he should still be allowed to become King or not?

Yes	39%
No	55%

Q8. If over several years, a marriage between Prince Charles and Camilla proved to be a loving and happy one, do you think he should become King?

Yes	46%
No	47%

Q9. And do you think Camilla should become Queen by his side?
