ICM Research interviewed a random sample of 1,178 adults aged 18+ by telephone on September 4-5th 1998. Interviews were conducted across the country and the results have been weighted to the profile of all adults.

Q1. Which of the following social classes do you feel you belong to?	
Upper	1%
Middle	41%
Working	55%
Don't know	3%

Q2. Which of those social classes do you feel your parents belong or belonged to?	
Upper	2%
Middle	27%
Working	69%
Don't know	2%

Q3. Do you think the present government is committed to the interests of all social classes equally, or more committed to the interests of one class in particular?	
Committed to all classes equally	45%
More committed to one social class	47%
Don't know	8%

Q4. Which one social class is the present government more committed to?	
BASE: all who think the government is more committed to one social class (552)	
Upper	35%
Middle	36%
Working	27%
