ICM/Daily Mirror Poll - June 2000

ICM Research interviewed 1000 adults aged 18+ by telephone on 9th-11th June 2000. Interviews were conducted across the country and the results have been weighted to the profile of all adults.

Q1. What are the top three things which you think would make the NHS better for you and your family?	
Shorter or no waiting lists	55%
More doctors and nurses	47%
Better pay for doctors and nurses	38%
Specialist units for things like cancer or heart disease	28%
More money in general	22%
Fewer bureaucrats/less administration	19%
More hospitals	19%
Giving more responsibility to nurses	9%
Renovated hospitals	7%
Doctors to have control over their own budgets	6%
Get rid of NHS Trusts	4%
Other	8%
